



- A. The Great Lakes are a group of lakes in the mid-east area of North America bordering Canada. Lake Superior is not only the largest of the Great Lakes but also the largest freshwater lake in the world by surface area. It contains more water than the other four lakes combined. So much water, in fact, that it could cover the whole of North and South America with one foot of water.
- B. Lake Michigan is the only one of the five lakes to be completely located inside the United States, the other four lakes are shared by the U.S. and Canada. Technically, it is the same lake as Lake Huron as they are linked by the Strait of Mackinac. The word "Michigan" comes from the native American word michi-gami, which means "great water".
- C. Lake Huron is the eastern part of Lake Michigan-Huron. It was actually the first of the Great Lakes to be discovered by European explorers. One of the most interesting features of the lake is Manitoulin Island, which is the largest freshwater island in the world.
- D. Lake Erie is the shallowest of the five lakes, its average depth is only 19 meters. It is the largest freshwater fishery in the world, boosting the economy by over 1 billion dollars every year. People from all over the world come to Lake Erie to fish.
- E. Lake Ontario is the last on the Great Lake chain and serves as the outlet to the Atlantic Ocean. Throughout its history there have been 50 people who have swum across the lake. The very first person to accomplish this was 16-year-old Marilyn Bell in 1954.

The area was originally occupied by an ethnic group of people called the Zulu who had migrated to the south from other parts of Africa over a thousand years ago. South Africa later became a Dutch colony and after that a British colony. In 1961, the country gained independence from Britain and became a republic.
- B. In 1948, the government classified the South African population into races and gave them different rights. This legal segregation known as apartheid ended in 1993 with the release of Nelson Mandela, an anti-apartheid revolutionary, after 27 years in prison. Nelson Mandela became the first black president of South Africa.
- C. The Boer Wars were a series of conflicts between the Dutch settlers of South Africa (the Boers) and the British colonists. After France invaded the Dutch Republic during the Napoleonic Wars, the British invaded South Africa and took control. This caused a lot of tension between the Dutch and British colonists and resulted in several wars of independence.
- D. South Africa has 11 official languages including Zulu (the language of the Zulu tribes, native to the area), Afrikaans (a Germanic language that evolved from Dutch) and English. The three most spoken languages are Zulu, Xhosa (a native African Bantu language, notable for its use of click consonants) and Afrikaans, although English is recognized as the language of commerce and science.
